One of the questions raised at the meeting concerned the issue surrounding the use of a Green Card and Brexit. I said I would come back to you with the advice that FBD were putting out to their customers and I have set it out below for you.

**In the event of a 'hard BREXIT' EU citizens driving in the UK outside would be required them to carry a 'green card'.**

- ***What does a hard BREXIT mean for FBD motor customers?***

If a 'no deal' BREXIT were to take place then anyone taking their Irish registered motor vehicle to the UK, including Northern Ireland will require a green card.

- ***What is a Green Card?***

A Green Card is an internationally recognised insurance document which provides proof of the minimum compulsory motor insurance cover required by the country visited. It is a hard copy document which is printed on green paper or with a green background.

- ***How will FBD Customers get a Green Card?***

If an FBD customer calls for a green card they should log on to <https://www.fbd.ie/greencard/> All they need to do is enter their registration number and click 'submit', once this is done a Green Card will automatically be issued by post within three working days.

- ***What if our Customer does not have access to the internet***

If a customer does not have internet access you can go to <https://www.fbd.ie/greencard/> on their behalf, put in their registration number and click 'submit'

- ***Where Can FBD Customers learn more about BREXIT's impact on their Insurance?***

The best place to find out about the impact of BREXIT on motor insurance is on the Motor Insurance Bureau of Ireland (MIBI) web site [www.mibi.ie](http://www.mibi.ie)

What I have set out above is what FBD are advising their customers. Other insurers may have a different interpretation.
